





Creating a DFAP Online Account

This guide provides step-by-step information on how to create your DFAP Online Application account.

Step 1: Go to 22007apply.gov, then click 'Apply Here'.




Step 2: Select 'Sign Up' at the bottom of the 'Account Login' screen.



Step 3: Enter your Email Address

On the 'Create Account' page, enter your email address, then select 'Continue'.



Step 4: Create your Password

Create your password, then select 'Continue'.

Your password must be at least eight (8) characters long and contain at least three (3) of the following: lower case letters, upper case letters, numbers, and/or special characters.





Step 6: Login to Your Account


A message opens to confirm you verified your email address. Select 'Login'.



Enter your email address, then select 'Continue'.



Enter your password, then select 'Continue'.




Step 7: Choose Authentication Method

Select a method to verify your account. The DFAP Online Application uses a multi-factor 2-step verification process to keep your account secure.

Choose the method for receiving your one-time code:


1. Select 'Google Authenticator or similar' to use an authenticator app to generate a code.
2. Select 'Text me a code (SMS)' to receive a verification code by SMS/text message.



Step 8: Get a One-Time Code

If you selected 'Text me a code (SMS)':

1. Enter your mobile phone number, then click 'Continue'.



2. Check your text message for the one-time verification code.

3. Enter the code in the designated box, then click Continue.

If you selected 'Google Authenticator or simar':

1. Open your authenticator app, then scan the QR code. The authenticator app will generate a one-time verification code.
2. Enter the code in the designated box, then click Continue.




Step 9: Enable Fingerprint or Face Recognition (optional)

If your device uses fingerprint or face recognition, you can enable your account to use fingerprint or face recognition to log you in. You should only set up fingerprint or face recognition on a trusted device.

- Select 'Continue' to enable this feature. Follow the instructions on your device to finish the setup.
- Select 'Remind me later' to enable fingerprint or face Recognition at a future login.
- Select 'Not on this device' if you do not wish to use fingerprint or face recognition.
